**Southeast Asian Countries and Active Aging Consortium Asia Pacific
Meeting and Workshop on
“DESIGNING AGE FRIENDLY COMMUNITIES
TO ENHANCE AGING IN PLACE”
13 -14 October 2011
Bali, Indonesia**

The global population is ageing. In Asia and the Pacific, the number of older people is growing rapidly, from 410 million in 2007 to about 733 million in 2025, and to an expected 1.3 billion in 2050. In terms of percentages, the older people will constitute about 15% of the total population in 2025 and up to nearly 25% by 2050, from over 10% now. In relation to this, one-half of the older population lives in developing countries. One of these developing countries is Indonesia. Indonesia currently has the tenth largest population of elderly. In 2020, its number of older people will steadily increase to 28.8 million (11% of total population).

Based on the above mentioned background, we have the pleasure to announce that the Centre for Ageing Studies Universitas Indonesia, National Commission for Older Persons of The Republic of Indonesia, Active Aging Consortium Asia Pacific, and Indonesian Academy of Sciences organize a Regional Meeting that discussed topic on Designing Age Friendly Community to enhance Ageing in Place. Experts from Southeast Asian Countries, other regions of Asia-Pacific, and Europe will share new trends and developments in Intergenerational Relationships, Aging in Place, Age Friendly City, Universal Design, Housing, Community Care, Family Care Giving, and International Migration for Elder Care, and other topics.

Speakers will discuss how best-practices fit the economic and cultural situations of different Southeast Asian and East Asian countries as we all strive to Design

Age Friendly Communities to enhance Aging in Place. The meeting will be held in conjunction with the International Day of Older Persons, which is October 1st.

In this meeting, there will be a signing of agreement of implementation between Oxford Institute of Population Ageing (University of Oxford, UK) and Centre for Ageing Studies Universitas Indonesia as well as an awarded of Honorary Visiting Research Fellow to the Director of Centre for Ageing Studies Universitas Indonesia, Prof. Tri Budi W. Rahardjo, by Professor Sarah Harper who is the Director of Oxford Institute of Population Ageing. Both of these occasion is a follow up of a long collaboration in research which has started from 1999.

This meeting is supported by 7 supporters which are Ministry of Social Affairs Republic of Indonesia, Ministry of National Education Republic of Indonesia, Indonesian Academy of Sciences, Japan Foundation Center for Global Partnership, Asian Aging Business Center (Fukuoka, Japan), Martina Berto Group of Company, and Kalbe Farma Group of Company.

This meeting is also has 13 collaborators which are Office of Public Health Studies (University of Hawai'i at Manoa, USA), Oxford Institute of Population Ageing (University of Oxford, UK), Kumamoto Gakuen University (Japan), Prosthodontic Department (Faculty of Dentistry Universitas Indonesia), Research Institute Science of Better Living for the Elderly (Korea), Asia-Pacific Institute of Ageing Studies (Lingnan University, Tuen Mun, Hong Kong), Indonesian Institute of Aging (Lembaga Lanjut Usia Indonesia), School of Sports, Exercise and Health Sciences (University of Loughborough, UK), Bali Province Government, Secretariat of Bali Province Commission for Older Persons, ILC – Singapore and Tsao Foundation Singapore, Universitas Respati Yogyakarta, and Senior Club Indonesia.

The number of participants for this meeting is 219 people who are from Indonesia (180 persons), USA, (5 persons), Japan (8 persons), UK (3 persons), Malaysia

(2 persons), Thailand (1 persons), Hongkong (4 persons), Singapore (9 persons), and Korea (7 persons). All participants are able to attend International Conference on “The Population Aging Explosion: Opportunities and Challenges” on 12 October 2011, and Southeast Asian Countries and Active Aging Consortium Asia Pacific Meeting and Workshop on “Designing Age Friendly Communities to Enhance Aging in Place” on 13-14 October 2011.

This meeting is divided into Panel 1, 2, and 3 with topics:

1. Age Friendly Cities and Communities, with the output is a draft of policy recommendation.
2. Capacity Building in Caregiving and Long Term Care, with the output is a standard for capacity building in caregiving and long term care.
3. Intergenerational Relationships, with the output is a draft of recommendation.

This meeting is also divided into workshop 1 and 2:

1. Workshop 1 Developing Research Proposal on Designing Age Friendly Community and Cities, with the output is a proposal draft.
2. Workshop 2 Capacity Building on Care Giving, with the output is a standard for capacity building on care giving

There is also free papers or poster session which is followed by 42 participants from Indonesia, Japan, UK, Hongkong, and Korea. The topics in this poster session are vary from dementia to oral health.

We would like to thank to Universitas Indonesia, AIPI, supporters and collaborators for their contributions and supports. We also would like to thank to all speakers, committee members, and participants of the Conference and Workshop. We do hope that results of this Conference will be benefited for policy recommendation, education and research development, to widen scientific knowledge and the implementation in various institutions regarding population aging explosion.
